Now that we're in wing ~~I~~ we're upperclassman. Our subjects are tough and I'm not at all sure that I'll pass them but here's hoping. I'm studying Physics hard. Physics, Code and aircraft Identification is all I'll have to pass before Primary and I sure hope I can do it. We just have about 4 1/2 more who's here (if I pass)

Guess who I got a letter from the other day? Carl Showalter. He is in the Pacific somewhere, and seeing plenty of action.

Our P.T. is a lot tougher now and so are inspections Parades and everything.



Get me Bill Phalen's address as soon as possible will you. He just went in the army and he said in his last letter he said that he would be in in a w/b or so. I expect you'll have to get it from his mother.

We have a theater right across the street from us now and for once we can go to the show without standing in line. our first open post comes around Sun. we've only had 2 days off since we've been here and maybe that will give you an idea of how hard we're working here. We get a chance to go to church on Sunday at least.

We have a Parade 3 times a week and boy are they hot and tiring. a lot of boys fall out out so far I'm lucky I guess.

In our barracks now we have plenty of room. Only 33 men are in here instead of 43. That makes a lot of
